



SPECIAL HOLY WEEK SERVICE



This year our Holy Week services will look and feel a little different. Holy Week begins with Palm Sunday. For several years our Palm Sunday service has begun with the celebration of the triumphant entry of Jesus into Jerusalem and ended with a focus on the Passion of Jesus and the stripping of the sanctuary. This year the stripping of the sanctuary will be blended into the Maundy Thursday Tenebrae service as part of a dramatic illustration to accompany our reflection on the passion and death of Jesus. Again this year several carefully selected musical numbers will supplement the Tenebrae readings and our experience of these dark but grace-filled moments.

I encourage you now to place this Maundy Thursday service on your calendar to insure that your Lent/Easter experience leads you to the shadow of the cross before the miracle of the empty tomb.
