

\*PILGRIMAGE MODULE 5 WILL BE OFFERED ON 10/26, 11/9 and 11/15—11/16. This module will focus on "What is the UMC?" and will explore the structure of the church at the local, district, conference and general church level. It will take a quick look into our church's history and people who helped to shape the life of the early Methodist movement. Module 5 includes an overnight trip to Nashville, TN to visit three general church offices, along with the Upper Room chapel, museum and bookstore. In addition to the 10/26 and 11/9 sessions to take place from 6:30—8:00 pm in Rm 202, the third and final session of Module 5 will take place during the trip to Nashville (11/15—11/16) with over half of the material to be presented then. Attendees will be asked to cover the cost of the overnight trip. Sign-up is through the Registration and Attendance Sheet process, including for childcare. The Pilgrimage is basically an adult version of the confirmation classes offered at Murphysboro United Methodist Church to junior high and high school youth. Participants are not required to have participated in earlier modules.
