

LENT PRAYER MINISTRY: Lent is a time of repentance, fasting and preparation for the coming of Easter. WHY ATTEND MAUNDY THURSDAY / TENEBRAE SERVICE?

On the day we recognize Maundy Thursday (Holy Thursday), we will offer a Tenebrae Service or "Service of Shadows." Tenebrae comes from the Latin word meaning "darkness." Before we can truly receive the light and joy of the resurrection of Christ, we must first experience the darkness of a world without God following Jesus' death. Through readings, carefully selected musical numbers, and the extinguishing of candles we will experience these dark but grace-filled moments.

You are encouraged to include this Maundy Thursday service on your calendar to insure that your Lent/Easter experience leads you to the shadow of the cross before the miracle of the empty tomb.
