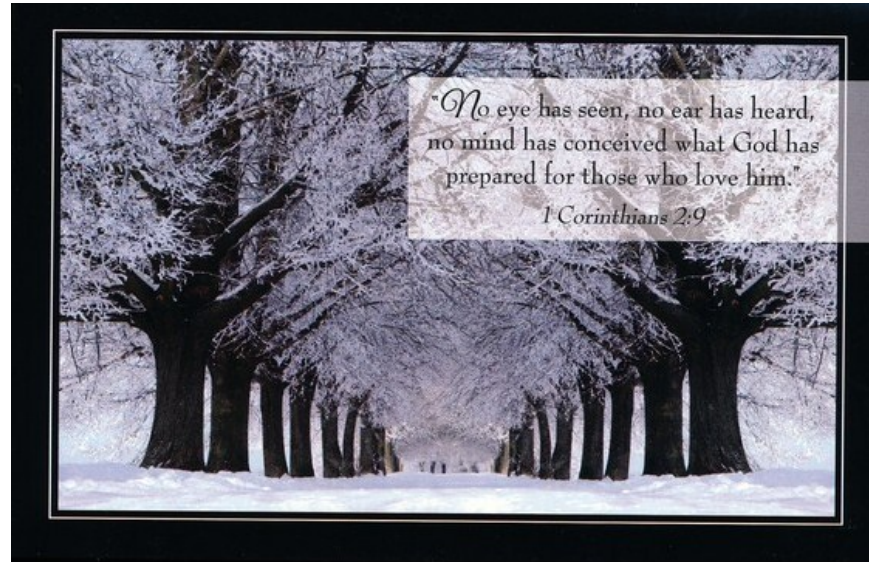

Simple Cobbler

1 c. self-rising flour 1 c. sugar 1 c. milk 1 stick butter

Mix above ingredients together and pour into greased 9x9 baking dish. Spoon and spread pie filling of your choice over the batter. Bake at 350 degrees until golden (about 45-60 minutes). You can double the recipe for a 9x13 dish and bake for an hour.

The ART OF MARRIAGE

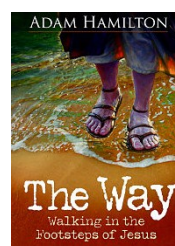
MUMC is sponsoring *The Art of Marriage* video event in the Masada Lodge, Little Grassy Campground, on April 5th and 6th.
