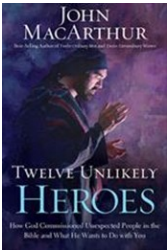

We hope to see children enjoy this experience in June and then come to Vacation Bible School in July which starts on Sunday, July 14th, and will be another great experience for children.

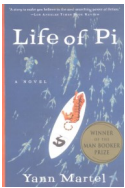
