

Pastor Larry will be hosting a communion assistant training on Sunday, October 12, 3:00-4:00 p.m. If you would like to occasionally assist with serving communion on Sunday mornings, in either service, please consider attending this training. Gum Drop Kids is a non-profit organization that was formed in January, 2008. They provide weekend meals for about 1,400

kids per week in school districts from Mt. Vernon to Cairo, IL. They have packed 165,242 bags since January, 2008. The food is child-friendly to enhance the quality of life for atrisk children throughout Southern Illinois.

Service and Mission Team has been delivering to Murphysboro Schools since 2011, and last school year over 4,000 food bags were delivered here. Gum Drop Kids is offering a special packing night for MUMC on Oct. 12, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. We will take the church van and pack as a group. The van will leave the church parking lot at 5:30 p.m. What a wonderful opportunity for our church family to help with this worthwhile ministry!
