Mt. Vernon to Cairo, IL. They have packed 165,242 bags since January, 2008. The food is child-friendly to enhance the quality of life for at-risk children throughout Southern Illinois.

Service and Mission Team has been delivering to Murphysboro Schools since 2011, and last school year over 4,000 food bags were delivered here. Gum Drop Kids is offering a special packing night for MUMC on Oct. 12, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. We will take the church van and pack as a group. The van will leave the church parking lot at 5:30 p.m. What a wonderful opportunity for our church family to help with this worthwhile ministry! 




