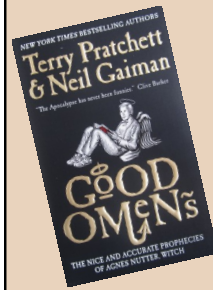
2016 Children's Story Time

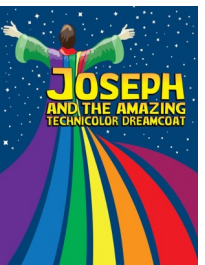
