



due on September 15th. Deadline for signup is August 14th. Contact Gene Schwebel or Erin Mileur for more information. You may also check the Camp Restore box on our Registration and Attendance sheet to receive additional information.

Camp Restore is the only remaining organization in New Orleans still working on restoration. They have had over 45,000 volunteers in the 11 years since Katrina. There remains a lot in New Orleans still needing restoration. Last year seven from MUMC stepped up to repair a collapsing dining room ceiling for a mother and her three daughters. Our missionaries also removed foliage and debris to permit entrance to the family's beloved green house. A second project completed involved concrete removal and replacement in front of a small grocery store.
