I want to take just a moment to update you on our work in DeSoto and extend to each of you an invitation.

We are currently conducting a weekly program on Wednesday evenings for persons of all ages. Last week we had over 20 children present and almost that many adults.

Beginning October 16th, we will hold the first of three information meetings, with a goal to gather approximately 30 adults to begin the new worship services. Services are to begin monthly in January, and weekly the first of April.

I would like to invite and encourage each of you to pray about any role God might have for you to be involved in the ministries at our DeSoto site. I would like you to prayerfully consider if God may be asking you to participate significantly in the life of the DeSoto church, and maybe even make the DeSoto site your primary place for Sunday worship, once worship services begin. God is doing a great thing in DeSoto. Many others and I are humbled to be a part of it. God may be asking you to be a part of it as well. Please pray about this with an open heart.
