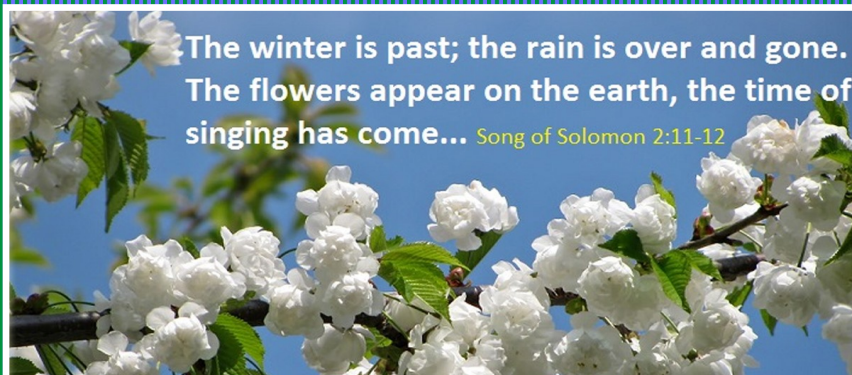
Those unable to view this service via facebook live, later in the day you may view the service through our website link to our UMC's YouTube. From our website at:
