Relay for Life Luminaries & Information was sent out last week they are due to Wilma by May 25th.

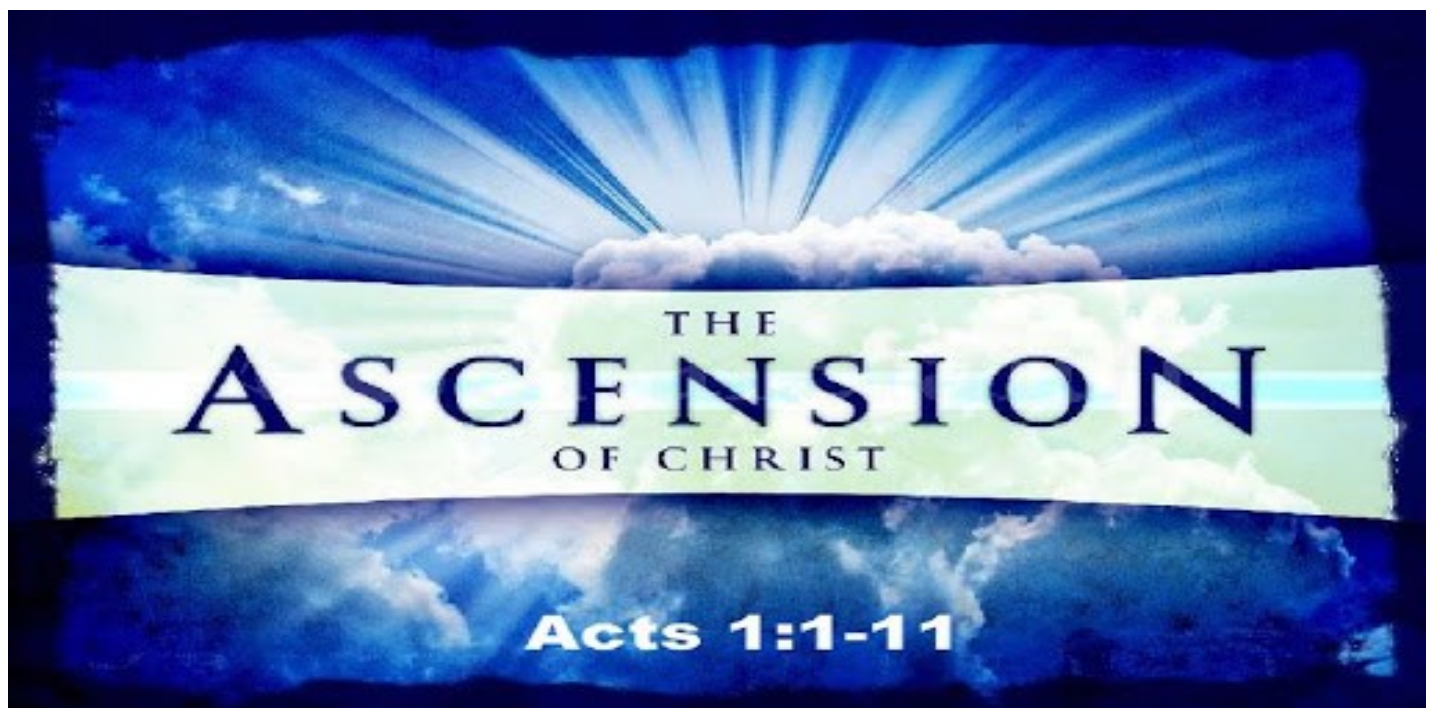
