As I sit here finishing up this article for the newsletter, Autumn is in full force in Southern Illinois and Thanksgiving is only four weeks from this coming Thursday. Can you believe that? To me, we are so blessed to live in a part of the country where we can truly experience all four seasons. Of course, each season has its own unique beauty, and I don't know about you, but I love everything about this special time of year – the cool days and even cooler nights, the changing colors of the leaves, the houses decorated with pumpkins and mums, the smell of burning leaves in the air, and the anticipation of the holiday season to come. In addition, a special blessing for me is that on my daily commute to and from Murphysboro I cross Crab Orchard Lake and I always anticipate the arrival of the white pelicans as they migrate through the area. I had not seen them until yesterday, but a dozen of them were happily swimming in the lake waters enjoying the beautiful sunny day. This is just another assurance to me of God's consistency in our lives and how he works through nature to comfort us and bring us joy.

Another thing that brings me joy during this season of the year is when I think about the familiar hymns such as *Come*, *Ye Thankful People*, *Come*, and *We Gather Together*, that we, as a church family, sing as we ponder what it means to be genuinely thankful and count our many blessings. As I think about the beautiful words and music echoing in the sanctuary, I also think about the 15<sup>th</sup> anniversary of my cancer surgery, which was on October 17, and the uncertainty that situation brought to myself and Mike, and our family and friends, as to what was in store next. And, if you are willing to admit it, as I am, even Christians deal with uncertainties that inhabit our minds and sometimes cause us to lose sleep at night. But, Praise God we can have faith and confidence in our Creator who is never uncertain about our future. Just as we can count on the seasons to come and go, we can count on God to be with us through the changing seasons of our lives. That season of my life, when I dealt with a cancer diagnosis, surgery, and treatments, brought some struggles, but it also brought many blessings, and many reasons to be thankful which I will never forget.

As a church family we have the opportunity to gather together on Sunday, November 12 at 5:00 pm in the MUMC Fellowship Hall to celebrate the season of Thanksgiving by sharing a meal, giving thanks, and counting our many blessings. This is a wonderful time to gather together over a meal and just enjoy the fellowship of Christian believers. And, please feel free to invite family, friends, and neighbors to join us in this special gathering as we acknowledge what it means to have a truly grateful heart.

And, that leads me into my conclusion as I share the lyrics of another one of my favorite songs, *Give Thanks With A Grateful Heart* that is often sung this time of year, but is appropriate anytime:


Please continue to pray the "Breakthrough Prayer" as a loving church body. Time to pray as a whole is 4:00 pm daily.
