

Please join the Seekers Adult Sunday School Class as they continue their in-depth study of the Book of Acts by English New Testament scholar, Pauline theologian, and Anglican bishop, N. T. Wright. Adults of all ages are welcome and encouraged to attend for a time of study, fellowship, and prayer. And, please stay tuned for information on the upcoming Advent study which will begin on Sunday, November 30.



Hello men. We will begin a topical bible study on "Lessor Known Men of The Bible". Our first person of interest is:

Shamgar: He was a Judge over Israel, and his story can be found in the book of Judges. Below are those citations with hyperlinks to allow you access to more information:

Note: You don't have to be a study before coming. We will have an open discussion after I explain what the texts mean and might

mean. The information below helps those who want to take a deeper dive...

Shamgar, son of Anath (Hebrew: שַׁמְגַּר Šamgar), is the name of one or possibly two individuals named in the Book of Judges. The name occurs twice:

- 1. at the first mention, Shamgar is identified as a man who repelled Philistine incursions into Israelite regions, and slaughtered 600 of the invaders with an ox goad (Judges 3:31);[1]
- 2. the other mention is within the Song of Deborah, where Shamgar is described as having been one of the prior rulers, in whose days roads were abandoned, with travelers taking winding paths, and village life collapsing (Judges 5:6).[2]

By T.C. Boyle






There will be no Book Club meeting in December. The read ahead book for January is **The Great River: The Making & Unmaking of the Mississippi** by Bruce Upholt.
